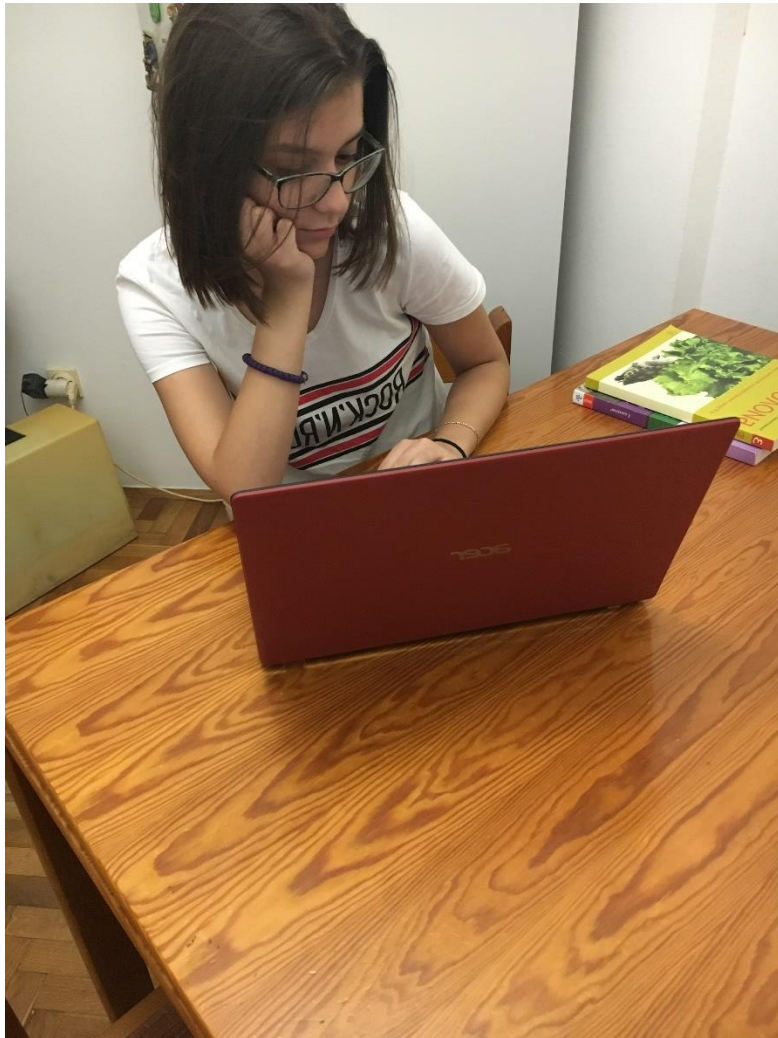


IVANA IVANEŽA, 3RD GRADE
